More about DENS:

Last year we donated 377 kg of food to DENS. Our donation has enabled them to continue offering emergency food parcels to local people, including some in Bovingdon and the local area, supporting them through crisis.

The range of services DENS provides helps homeless people make positive changes to their lives, learn new skills and to build their confidence and ultimately assist people to move on into independent living.

Weekly, the Foodbank provides food to the DENS Elms Hostel, which accommodates 44 residents, and to the Day Centre who have provided 2045 meals throughout the year.
