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### **Company Covenants**

A Limited Liability Company will pay the total donation to the charity. This total annual amount of the covenant can then be set against pre-tax profits when computing corporation tax liability. Therefore when a Limited Liability Company makes a covenant to a charity, the value of this covenant is much greater than the net cost to the company. For example, if a company paying 25% corporation tax makes a donation under a 3 year covenant of £10,000 to a charity, it can set this against corporation tax. The company saves £2,500 in corporation tax and the net cost of the donation is therefore £7,500 or £2,500 a year.

Companies with profits under £50,000 currently pay 19% corporation tax.
